www.frisina.ch art@frisina.ch In this photography, a split second shot of a tree is represented. However, the camera is not kept still, but set in motion, moving from top to bottom. Through this technique, the spots of light between the leaves resemble a veil as if one would see curtains behind a reflective window or recognise trees in these reflections.

The resulting illusions put the question of what is true reality in a new light.

Does it conform to a true representation of reality, as we understand it in photography? Photography seems to be something technical and objective. "Illusion" shows that - although no image editing programmes have been used - the photographs present a completely different world, which was actually captured.
